**A** Outside cabin, 7-22 m<sup>2</sup>. Portholes, upper and lower beds. Three-berth cabins with upper bed.

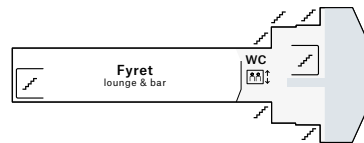
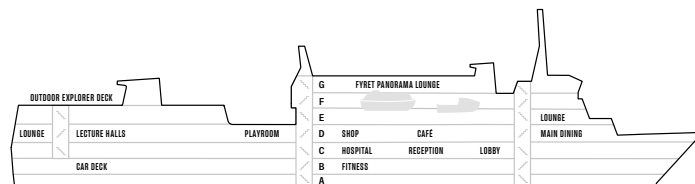

## POLAR INSIDE

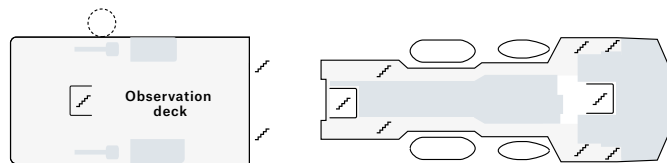
